How do I get my properties on to OnRequest?

This is done automatically when you upload your properties to realestate.com.au.

Using the service

Simply text the property ID to 0428 796 786 and you will receive a MMS¹ and SMS with the property details. The SMS ID is the same as the realestate.com.au property ID.

Advertising the service

SMS ID's can be incorporated into your print board templates.

For stock boards, use stickers with SMS ID's – these may be ordered online.

You can also advertise the service wherever you are currently advertising: newspaper, online, property magazines.

Usage Reports

Usage reports are sent to your office via email on a daily basis if there have been any requests for your properties. Or simply login to OnRequest, and select Properties > View Usage Report from the Navigation bar.

Using the online system

Log in via <http://onrequest.com.au/> and click 'Client Login' link.

From here you are able to view your properties, usage reports and send properties details to prospective buyers.

Sending mobile property brochures

Login into OnRequest, and from the dashboard you can select a property and send it to one or multiple mobile phones. You can also create and send SMS messages. Credit for sending messages can be purchased online.
